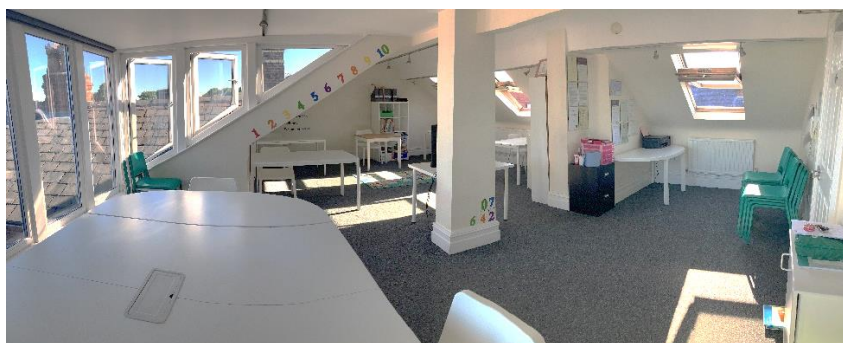

Why invest in Private Tuition?

There is no doubt that private tuition is not only an increasingly popular service but one that can, when delivered properly, have significant impact on a child's learning. A recent study commissioned by the Education Endowment Foundation in 2019 reported that tuition can deliver in the region of five months of additional progress to a child's learning. In order to achieve these results, the same study revealed that:

"programmes involving Teaching Assistants or volunteers can have a valuable impact, but tend to be less effective than those using experienced and specifically trained teachers."

Since 2016, Learn North West has remained steadfast in our commitment to only provide children with high quality tuition with **qualified, experienced** teachers. Children are taught by experts in their fields: we work with GCSE and A' Level examiners, teachers with specific SEN qualifications and experience as well as teachers who are specialists in their subjects and phases who are able to provide the most appropriate interventions for children that supports, extends and embeds their curriculum learning.

Because our teachers work extensively in schools, work together as a team and are committed to continued professional development, our teachers have recent and up to date knowledge of curriculum demands ensuring that we can deliver, with precision, the most effective support for our students.

Tuition Options

Our team work with you specifically to support your child's individual needs. We offer traditional one-to-one tuition alongside paired and small group classes in which children receive individual tuition in a small, nurturing group setting where children benefit enormously from interaction with their peers as well as the individual attention of their teacher.

Is group tuition as effective?

The Education Endowment Foundation's study that evaluated the impact of 30 hours of tuition in a 12-week period found that "in some cases one to one tuition led to greater improvement, while in other cases tuition in small groups has been **equally or even more** effective." Where, on average, a child receiving one to one might make around 5 months of progress, a child in a small group might make around 4 months of progress thereby meaning that the small group tuition with a highly qualified teacher delivers better value for money at £12-22 p/hour compared to one-to-one tuition at £32-£37 p/hour.

Where does tuition take place?

Our group and much of our one-to-one tuition takes place at our **Ofsted registered** classroom in Altrincham. We are conveniently located adjacent to the Altrincham Retail Park: 199 Manchester Road, Altrincham, WA14 5NU.

Our classroom is bright and airy, we are well resourced and provide a conducive environment for learning. Some of our teachers do provide home visits and work online, however, we find that children get the most from their learning when they are in a productive working environment and have the mind set for learning which our classroom ensures. Because our classroom is Ofsted registered you can be reassured that we uphold the highest standards and education, safety and pupil wellbeing; all our teachers are subject to enhanced DBS checks, we hold up to date and relevant First Aid qualifications and we can also accept a range of childcare vouchers as payment for your tuition that takes place at our centre.
